

What are we contacting you about?

We are pleased to provide the latest in our series of regular quarterly updates regarding Bellhouse landfill site at Stanway, operated by Enovert South Ltd.

This is now the third of our quarterly updates in which we provide information on our regulation of the site, and share any reported problems that may have a localised impact and any other relevant information.

What has happened since the last update?

A new internal haul road and wheel-wash system have been installed, which should greatly reduce the potential for mud tracking from the site and secondary dust arising.

The operators have increased the number of staff and resources on site to reduce the potential for amenity issues including, but not limited to, litter and pests.

There is a planned schedule of work, starting this month, to install gas collection pipe work and associated infrastructure on the tipping cell. These works are standard gas control works and not reactive.

In the last three months the number of reports received regarding odour from Bellhouse, have remained significantly lower than at peak periods of last year.

What happens now?

We still plan to undertake an audit of the landfill gas and leachate management systems for the site. The audits will review any improvements made and advise on any further developments that may be necessary in the future.

We will also continue to monitor the operation of the site through routine compliance visits.

Regular odour monitoring in the close proximity environment will also continue.

Due to the fast paced and ever changing nature of the current Coronavirus pandemic, with any site visit, we must comply with the current government guidance for safe operations and if appropriate some routine activity may have to be rescheduled.

How do I report odour?

Please continue to report odour that you think is coming from the site to our incident hotline on 0800 80 70 60. We will investigate your report and provide you with feedback if you request it.
